



1. Our view of the Bible At TCC we believe

4. Our view on education At TCC we believe

6. Our view of the child At TCC we believe

 - As a result of their fallenness, students need training and external boundaries.

 - The goal for each child is to hear “well done good and faithful servant”.
7. Our view of the role of parent At TCC we believe

 - Parents need to have high expectation of what their child can achieve.
